RE: Chualar School to Resume Classes, March 15, 2023

Pacific, Gas and Electric (PG&E) has restored all power to our Chualar community and school. Board President, Mrs. Martha Gallegos and members of the Board of Trustees together with the Faculty and Staff of Chualar School want to extend our appreciation for everything you had to do to prepare to meet the demands of your family and home during these unprecedented days of inclement weather. We want to extend our appreciation to our maintenance who extended an unconditional effort to monitor and repair any and all facility issues brought about by this inclement weather during these last several days including Saturday. They cleaned and sanitized all classes and facilities in preparation for your children's return to school.

During the recent inclement weather conditions, we were in constant communication with the Office of Emergency Services, County and local Officials, neighboring school districts, and the Monterey County Office of Education. The ongoing reports of road closures, evacuations orders, predictions of rising rivers and creeks led to our need to cancel classes for our traveling staff's safety as well as the safety of our school community. We are pleased the sun has returned with forecasts of clear weather for the rest of the week. **THEREFORE, WE WILL RESUME SCHOOL AND CLASSES ON WEDNESDAY, MARCH 15, 2023.** Please remember we have parent conferences scheduled Wednesday through Friday of this week under a **MINIMUM DAY SCHEDULE**. BUS Students - We plan to resume our bus route and regular pick-up schedule. Please plan accordingly as well.

On behalf of the Board of Trustees and school administration, we thank you for making the necessary emergency arrangements in your homes. We sincerely appreciate your patience and understanding as we look forward to your child(ren's) return to school. Finally, please know we will continue to monitor weather and road conditions to make alternative plans as needed. Please continue to look for any updates we might forward to you. We will send this information out again tomorrow morning at 6:00 a.m. as confirmation of our back-to-school plans. Please stay safe.
